The RAINBOW project intends to assure consistency, when relating international qualifications to the National Qualifications Framework (NQF), thus to the European Qualifications Framework (EQF), by establishing an alignment methodology that serves as a model for both practical skills-based and highly specialised qualifications.

EWF qualification system is used as an example, following its alignment with the EQF. RAINBOW focuses on Quality Assurance at European Level for enhanced transparency and recognition of skills and qualifications, in accordance with the ERASMUS+ support for Policy Reform sub-programme.
